

What can Access Health Mahoning Valley do for me?

Access Health Mahoning Valley is a nonprofit organization whose mission is to assure access to health care for low-income, uninsured residents of Mahoning and Trumbull Counties. AHMV will connect people with a doctor and a health care location or clinic, and will help you to get health care from doctors and clinics, specialty medical care, prescriptions, transportation, and interpreters if needed.

Corydon Palmer dentists and assistants volunteer to staff the AHMV Dental Program, which offers a clinic at the Choffin Career Center on the third Thursday of every month during the school year.

Residents of Mahoning and Trumbull counties aged 19 through 64 who are uninsured and not eligible for public insurance (Medicare, Medicaid, and Veteran's Administration), with a family income that does not exceed 200% of the federal poverty level, can receive help from AHMV.

Find out if you are eligible to enroll by calling Access Health Mahoning Valley at 330-373-0703. An appointment will be scheduled for you with an AHMV care coordinator. You will be given an enrollment packet with information, a member agreement and an enrollment form. Access Health Mahoning Valley will review your information to determine whether you are eligible to participate, after which you'll receive a member ID card. There is an annual \$10 membership fee.

Access Health Mahoning Valley does not provide the following services:

- Emergency Room Visits
- Ambulance Services
- Medical Supplies
